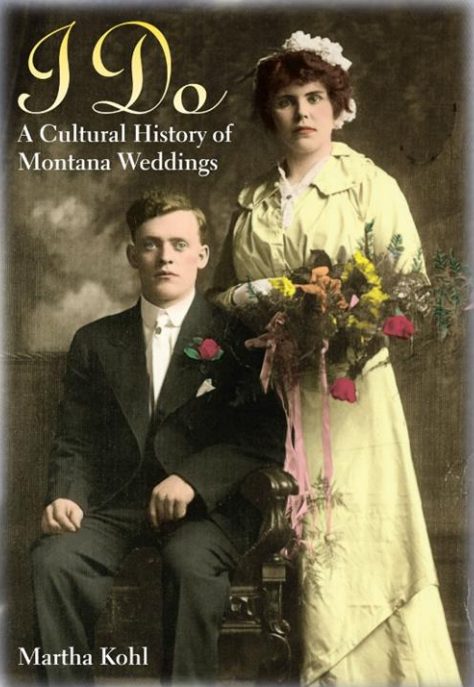


An Extreme History Project and Museum of the Rockies Presentation

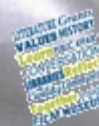
